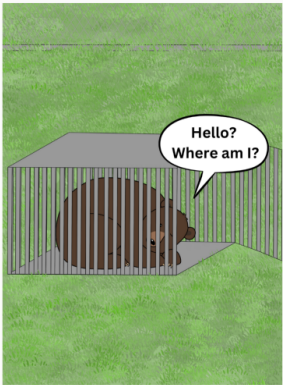
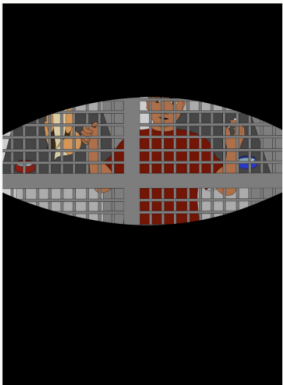
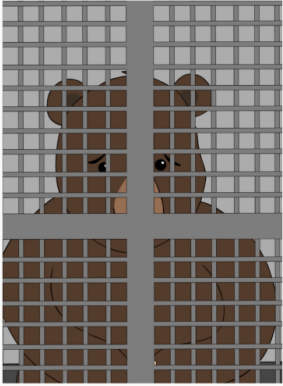
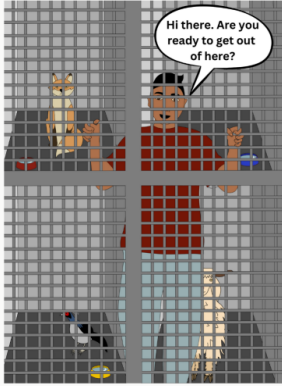
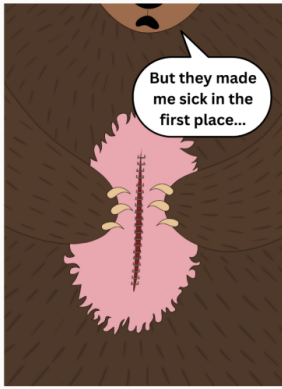


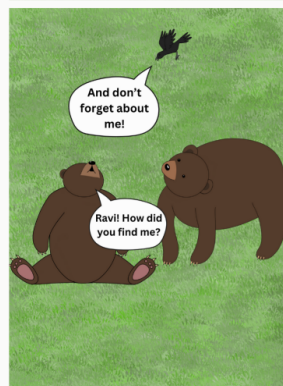
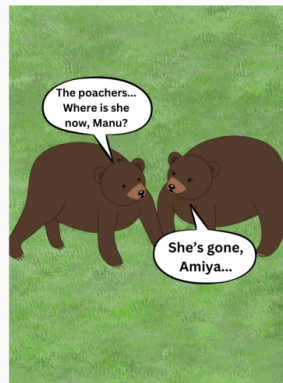
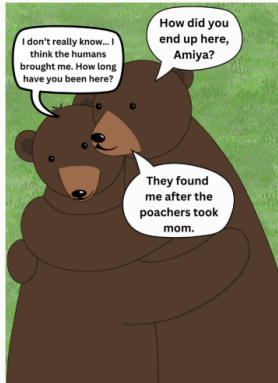
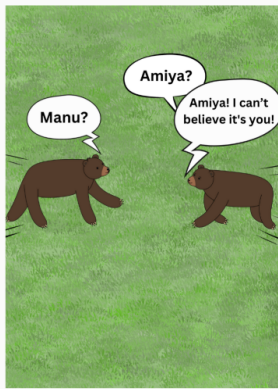
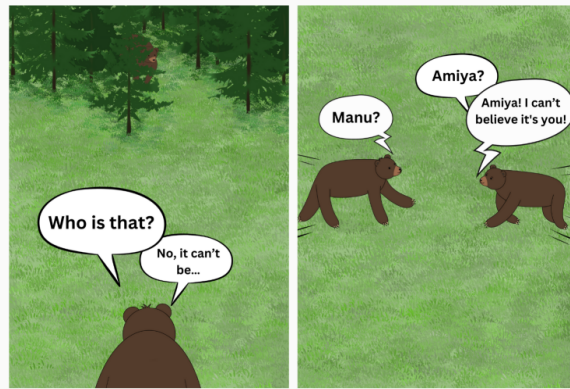
Have you caught up on Part III of Amiya and Ravi's journey? To go back and start from the beginning of their story, you will need to visit Part I.

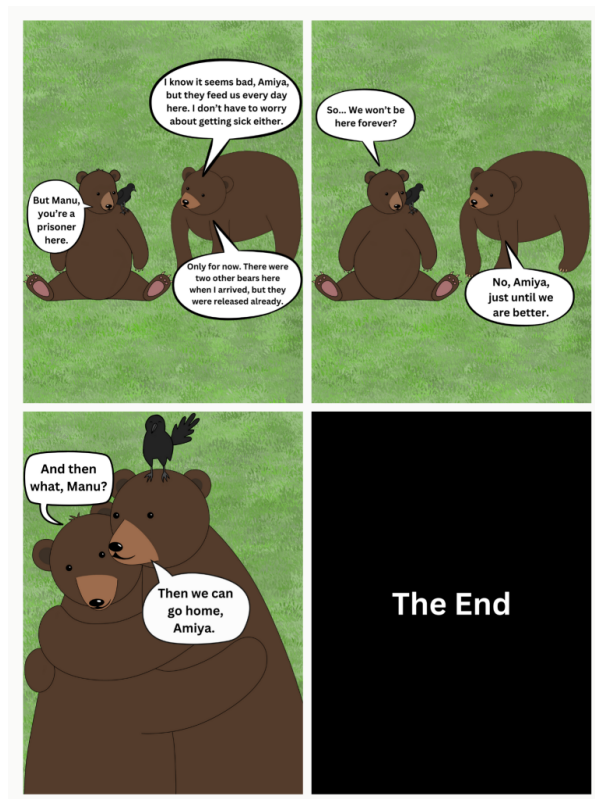
